OFFICE MEMORANDUM

BD.149/2012/141 : In pursuance of the decision taken by the State Cabinet of Assam on 28/02/2015, it is hereby directed that all Development Departments of the state of Assam shall earmark 5% of their Developmental fund from their Annual Budget every year for taking up projects/schemes located within the distance of 0-15 km from the inter-state boundary, and their implementation thereof.

The border districts of Assam with inter-state boundary where projects can be implemented are – (1) Sibsagar, (2) Jorhat, (3) Golaghat, (4) Karbi Anglong, (5) Dima Hasao, (6) Dhubri, (7) Cachar, (8) Hailakandi, (9) Karimganj, (10) Kokrajhar, (11) Udalguri, (12) Sonitpur, (13) Dhemaji, (14) Lakhimpur, (15) Morigaon, (16) Dibrugarh, (17) Goalpara, (18) Kamrup, (19) Kamrup (M), (20) Dhubri.

The concerned department shall constitute a committee with the concerned District Administration to decide the shelf of schemes/projects to be taken up based on the amount earmarked. The concerned department will implement the schemes/projects as per their existing rules/guidelines. A committee or an officer (not below the rank of Deputy Secretary) be assigned for inspection of the schemes/projects that are being implemented by them.

The concerned Department will apprise Border Areas Department of action undertaken by them for effective implementation of the schemes/projects in the Border Areas. For monitoring purpose, the Deputy Commissioner & Divisional Commissioner will monitor the schemes at field level and a Monitoring Cell will be constituted at state level in the Directorate of Border Areas, Assam and at Border Areas Department, Dispur.


